

## Subject: Provider and Wraparound Agency Home and Community Based Setting Rule

Magellan is committed to ensuring compliance with Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) regulations defining the settings in which it is permissible for states to pay for CSoC Waiver Services. The purpose of these regulations is to ensure that individuals receive CSoC Waiver Services in settings that are integrated in and support full access to the greater community. The regulations also aim to ensure that individuals have free choice of where they live and who provides services to them, as well as ensuring that individual rights are not restricted. The rule sets expectations for settings in which CSoC Waiver Services can be provided.

Magellan has developed a training titled <u>HCBS Setting Rule Provider and WAA Training 2019</u>, which is an annual mandatory training for all providers and Wraparound Agencies. All providers will be required to submit an attestation of completion of the training. This training should be completed no later than May 1, 2019, and annually thereafter.

Magellan monitors compliance with this annual requirement and failure to comply can impact your referral and/or network participation status.
