

Louisiana Crisis Response System Request for Applications

The Louisiana Center for Evidence to Practice, as part of its partnership with the LDH Office of Behavioral Health, is seeking qualified agency applicants who demonstrate the most readiness to proceed with crisis response training to serve the LA-CRS. Completion of this training is required to seek credentialing and contracting by Louisiana Medicaid Managed Care Organizations (MCOs), which is a separate step in the process to begin delivering services.

Youth LA-CRS Region 7 Services Needed

Region 7 encompasses nine parishes in the Northwest section of the state: Bienville, Bossier, Caddo, Claiborne, DeSoto, Natchitoches, Red River, Sabine, and Webster.

- **Mobile Crisis Response (MCR)** is an initial community-based, mobile crisis response intended to provide relief, resolution, and intervention to individuals where they are located through crisis supports and services during the first phase of a crisis in the community.
- **Community Brief Crisis Support (CBCS)** is an ongoing crisis intervention response rendered for up to fifteen (15) days and designed to provide relief, resolution, and intervention through maintaining the member at home / in the community, de-escalating behavioral health needs, referring for treatment needs, and coordinating with local providers.
